FOREWORD

The 23rd season of St. Paul City Conference girls basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 22nd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.

For the first time since 1991 the conference played a balanced double round-robin schedule. I applaud all that had anything to do with this and I hope that in future years the conference will continue to have each school playing each other twice. Because more games were played this year than last, direct comparison of statistics from this season to last season was not possible. To fairly compare the past two seasons I calculated the proportional number from last year. Any statistics that were calculated this way are noted with an asterisk (). This season I have included in this report several new sections: coaches all-time top five in wins, winning percentage and years coaching; conference all-time winning and losing streaks, including each team's winning and losing streaks. After years of researching I have also been able to acquire all scores from the first season (1974) and have added these scores to the all-time composite records.*



Cretin-Derham Hall won the conference title again, its record fifth title in a row. When the Tom Cody coached Raiders beat Washburn in the Twin Cities Game, it marked the fourth time in the last five years that the Raiders were victorious. It gives St. Paul an astounding 18-4 overall edge in this yearly battle of conference champions. Some of the highlights of this season: on January 30th the 100,000th point in the history of St. Paul City Conference girls basketball was scored.....Highland Park beat Cretin-Derham for the first time since 1986.....Central's Toya Poole won the scoring title, thus becoming the first Minutemaid to ever win a scoring crown.April Clairmont moved into second place on the all-time Humboldt scoring list with 541 points (Lisa Miller leads with 556 points).....Humboldt also broke conference records in free throws made (32) and attempted (51) in a game against Johnson.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls basketball. See ya!
