# **FOREWORD**

The 25th season of St. Paul City Conference girl's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 24th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. THANKS! You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.

With the addition of Arlington to the conference, each team played two additional games which meant that comparing stats directly from last year to this year was not possible. Since I prefer to make comparisons from one season to the next, I took last year's numbers and multiplied that figure proportionally to acquire a total for comparison. Any increase or decrease using statistics that were adjusted are noted with an asterisk (\*).

Cretin-Derham Hall won a record seventh straight conference title. The Tom Cody-coached Raiders have amassed an astounding 73-2 record during those seven years. They currently are riding a 33-game conference winning streak, second longest in conference history (Hill-Murray holds the all-time record of 42 games in 1980-1983). Coach Cody became the all-time winning coach in



the conference, surpassing Harding's Tom Gunderson, when he notched his 172nd career conference victory in Cretin-Derham's win over Johnson in February. The Raiders lost to Mpls. North (who ultimately would win the Class AAA state title) in the Twin Cities Game, then qualified for the state tournament, finishing second in the Class AAAA tournament! Congrats to the Raiders for their fine post-season run. Highland Park lost a heartbreaking overtime loss in the section finals, thus preventing the Scots from being a second conference entrant in the state tourney. Individual highlights: Humboldt's Annette Nelson completed her four-year conference career without missing a conference game

and set a Hawk record by appearing in 49 games. Johnson junior Lisa Harfield won the scoring title, becoming the first Governor to ever accomplish this feat. Lisa's average this season was 20.4, the tenth highest average for one season and the best since Harding's Shannon Loeblein's 21.8 in 1991. In scoring 286 points in the conference, she fell just three points short of tying Patty Lake's Johnson record set in 1984. Her 36-point game against Arlington is a Johnson conference record.

Next year the conference will mark its 100th anniversary. I hope players and coaches alike will share in the celebration that is planned and encourage you to be an enthusiastic supporter.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girl's basketball. See ya!
