
FOREWORD

The 26th season of St. Paul City Conference girl's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This was also a very special season in that it commemorated the centennial of the conference. My 25th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. THANKS! You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.

Cretin-Derham Hall won a record eighth straight conference title. The Tom Cody-coached Raiders have amassed an astounding 87-2 record during those eight years. In February the Raiders would log their 43rd straight conference win, surpassing the all-time mark set by Hill-Murray in 1980-1983. They would finish the season with the winning streak intact, now at 47. The next target to shoot for is the all-time boy's mark held by Central at 56 (1983-1987). Although the Raiders would lose to Mpls. North in the Twin Cities Game, there would be no shame in that. North would capture its second consecutive Class AAA state title. Cretin-Derham would win the Section 2AAAA title and



scoring crowns. Lisa would complete her four-year conference career with 823 points scored, third on the all-time scoring list. Tessa Tritabaugh, another talented senior in the conference, would finish her Central career with 647 conference points, placing her ninth on the all-time scoring. Harding's Kelly Scheunemann would break the school record for career conference three-pointers (53) and finish with 480 points, seventh on Harding's all-time list. Other conference records broken or tied: most three-point baskets by both teams in a game (a record 12, Central vs. Johnson), fewest fouls in game by one team (Cretin-Derham tied the record with one), and fewest fouls by both teams in a game (tied record of six, Cretin-Derham vs. Arlington).

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girl's basketball. See ya!
