FOREWORD

The 28th season of St. Paul City Conference girl's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 27th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

Central unseated nine-time conference champion Cretin-Derham Hall in winning its third title ever, its first undefeated conference season ever. The Minutemaids, coached by Willie Taylor, ended the record 67-game winning streak by the Raiders. They would break the school record of points in one game with 101 against Como Park. Central would go on and capture the Section 2AAAA title and advance to the state tournament for the first time since 1979 and came home with the third place trophy. Leading the Minutemaids was their talented junior guard Nakia Carlisle, who finished runner-up in the scoring race and added 250 points to her career total, placing her eighth on the all-time list with 725. She is now Central's all-time leading scorer in the conference and is poised next year to break the all-time scoring mark of 900 points by Harding's Shannon Loeblein (1988-1991). Another junior, Johnson's Christina Ford, led the conference in scoring with 276 points, the ninth highest single-season total ever. She becomes only the second Governor to win the scoring title (Lisa Harfield did it twice in 1998 and 1999). One more junior, Janet Klees from Highland Park, broke the single-season record for three-pointers with 32. Twice she tied the conference record of six three-pointers in a single game.



This season brought an end to the varsity coaching career of Tom Cody of Cretin-Derham Hall. In his record 21 years in the conference, he amassed 217 wins and eleven conference titles (both records). Six times his teams qualified for the state tournament, finishing second in 1998 and winning the state championship in 1999. What impressed me most about coach Cody was he never let his ego get in the way of coaching. He could have left starters in longer and ran up some scores but he chose to give more playing time to his bench and just settle for the win. He leaves some big shoes to fill and I am sure that he will continue to do, at some other level, what he does best -- coach and nurture young athletes into becoming players. He joins five other past St. Paul coaches into my Hall of Fame and will receive future copies of this report.

Lastly, I would like to mention something that I have put a lot of time and effort in over the last six months -- the conference athletic Web site. I have painstakingly added many of the records and stats to the site, including the scores from all 1,357 basketball games played in the conference since 1974. Visit the Web site at www.stpaulathletics.org and look for continued updates and additions in all sports (including photos).

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girl's basketball. See ya.
