FOREWORD

The 30th season of St. Paul City Conference girl's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 29th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

For the fourth time in conference girl's basketball history, there was a tie for the title. As was the case last year, Cretin-Derham Hall and Central shared the title with 13-1 records. Amazingly, both team's Junior Varsity and "C" Squad teams also tied for their respective titles with 13-1 records! Central would represent St. Paul in the annual Twin Cities Game, losing to Mpls. North (the Polars would go on to capture the Class AAA State Title). Three conference teams would advance to the section finals: Johnson losing in its first bid to ever appear in the State Tournament, Central losing to Woodbury who won the Class AAAA title, and Cretin-Derham, who won the Section 2AAAA crown and advanced to the State Tournament.



The three-pointer was dominant this season in the conference with numerous records falling. The conference would see a record 306 this season. Johnson would nail 85 during the conference season, shattering the previous record of 65 by Cretin-Derham in 2001. The Governors would make 11 in a game against Humboldt, also a record. Central and Cretin-Derham would combine for a record 14 in one game. Governor sophomore Krista Geiger-Simpson would make a conference record seven in a game against Arlington en route to 35 for the season, also a record (Janet Klees had made 32 in 2001).

For the second time in four years, there was a tie for the individual scoring title. To show you how difficult this fete is, the boys have never seen this happen in the 98 years of conference basketball. Underclassmen would dominate in the conference. To give you an idea of the future of the conference, only three seniors appeared in the top twenty in scoring. Two underclassmen, Central sophomore Ashley Ellis-Milan and Highland Park junior Tonia Jackson would tie for the scoring title. One senior that did excel over her non-senior peers was Cretin-Derham's Katie Kempe. She would dominate in free throw accuracy, nailing 37 out of 43 (86.6%) in helping the Raiders lead the conference in free throwing. For her conference career, Katie would finish second on the all-time list of free throwers with an outstanding conversion rate of 76.6%

There was an alarming statistic that did jump out – the conference converted 50.4% of all free throws, down drastically from last year's 54.5%. Two years ago it was a record 56.2% Hopefully, with the heavy influx of underclassmen, this accounted for this dramatic drop in converting free throws.
