## FOREWORD

The 32nd season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 31st annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central won its fifth consecutive city title and seventh overall crown in girls' basketball. The Minutemen would extend their conference winning streak to 26 games, a school record. Willie Taylor's talented Central squad would win the one game they have never won, the Twin Cities Game. When they defeated South 53-48, it was the first T.C. title in five tries for Central. They would go on to win the Section 3AAAA title and qualify for the state tournament. When they defeated Blaine in the quarterfinals, they extended their season-long winning streak to 24. But Hopkins would burst their bubble in the semis. Central would then finish the season by avenging an opening season loss to Lakeville and capture the third place game. They would finish the season with a 28-3 record, the most ever by a Central team. Congratulations to Central on a fantastic season!! Central would tie a conference record when they hit 11 three-pointers in a game against Humboldt. Como Park would win eight conference games, tying the Cougars for their most conference wins ever (they also had eight in 1981).

Ashley Ellis-Milan ended her remarkable career at Central by capturing her second scoring title. She scored 826 points in conference games which ranks fourth in the history of the conference. Her career conference average of 16.9 points also ranks fourth. Another senior in the conference, Jenna Giller of Como Park, completed her four-year career with a total of 670 conference points, ranking 15th overall. The talented sophomore duo from Johnson, Ebony Black and Angel Robinson, continued their assault on conference scoring records. Black climbed to 14th on the all-time scoring list with 674 points. She needs 275 points to surpass Central's Nakia Carlisle's all-time record of 948 points. Black's career conference average of 18.7 still ranks second overall while Robinson climbed from 22nd to 15th on this list with her 15.0 career average.

One thing that stood out while compiling this year's stats was the reduction of fouls called. This subsequently lowered the number of free throws made and attempted. This was true for girls and boys basketball. In boys' hoops, they fell by 13.4%; for the girls' it was even greater at 15.1%. This equates to almost five fewer fouls in each game. I am at a loss to explain why there was such a sharp drop in fouls assessed. And why was it prevalent for both girls and boys?
