FOREWORD

The 33rd season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 32nd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central won its sixth consecutive city title (eighth overall), extending the Minutemen's conference winning streak to 38. In the process, they would average a record 84.1 points in each conference game. Coach Willie Taylor's Central squad would win the tough Section 3AAAA crown and qualify for the State Tournament, finishing in third place. The 27 wins for the season were one shy of the team record, set last year. They did score 2,361 points throughout the season, the most ever by any St. Paul girls' basketball team. When reviewing this season's scoring, one cannot miss the abundance of underclassmen that will be returning next year. Of the top 15 scorers in the conference, there are two seniors, five juniors, six sophomores and two ninth graders! One of these, Theairra Taylor from Como Park, won the conference scoring title with a nifty 22.0 ppg average, narrowly beating out Central's Kiara Buford, who finished only four points behind. In the process, Theairra became only the second freshman to ever win the crown (Johnson's Ebony Black was the first in 2004). Speaking of Ebony, she is only 97 points away from becoming the conference's all-time leading scorer. But with the bevy of talented freshmen and sophomores, who knows how long she will hold on to that title?

This was the first season in which the state played two 18-minute halves rather than four eight-minute quarters. The additional playing time saw increases in several areas: scoring (an increase in points scored of 20.0%); free throws made (+17.1%), free throws attempted (+14.5%) and personal fouls (+12.1%). I think, on the whole, it was a better game with more time for more players to play. And there was more strategy involved with coaches utilizing their bench more than in the past.

My continuing research of the city conference is now focused on non-conference and post-season games. On the athletic Web site, I have added all of these to each season's results. I had hoped to include some of these statistics in this report but time did not allow it. Next year, I will have embellished school and coaching records that will include every girls' basketball game ever played by our schools!! Look for them next year in this report.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference athletic Web site (www.stpaulathletics.org). You will not only find basketball stats but results and standings from all conference athletic events.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.
