FOREWORD

The 34th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 33rd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central won its seventh consecutive city title (ninth overall), extending its conference winning streak to 50, the second longest in conference history. Cretin-Derham Hall holds that distinction at 67. In the process, they would average an incredible 93.7 points in each conference game, easily surpassing the record they set last year at 84.1. The Minutemen would also post a record for largest point differential in each conference game (62.2 points). Coach Willie Taylor's Central squad would annex the Twin Cities Game title from Mpls. South, avenging the loss they suffered to the Tigers in last year's T.C. Game. They would breeze through the always tough Section 3AAAA tournament and advance to the State Tournament, garnering the #1 seed. They would culminate their fantastic season by once again defeating South to capture the State Championship, the third such title for the Central girls (for additional info on Central's unbelievable year, see the next page).

There were numerous other team and individual highlights from this past conference season. Humboldt would shatter the conference record in three-point field goals in a game when it made 14 in a game against Harding. The Hawks Ayana Hicks would break the conference record for free throws made and attempted in a game against Highland Park when she made 17 out of 26 attempts. The previous records were 14 free throws made (Ann Schultz from Harding in 1984) and 24 attempts (Como Park's Sharlene Avery in 1988). The 26 attempts were one short of the state record. There were many noteworthy seniors that concluded their playing careers this season. Central's talented team included two players that have etched their names in the conference record book. Angel Robinson and Ebony Black would conclude their five year careers in St. Paul as the number two and three all-time scorers in conference games with 930 and 928 points, respectively. Ebony's career average in the conference was 16.9 ppg, third best ever. Johnson's Alex Moore won the conference scoring title averaging 20.8 per game. She became the fifth Governor to win the scoring crown. Fellow teammate Sasha Barnes would become the first player in the annals of our conference to play five years without missing a conference games (62).

My continuing research of non-conference and post-season games is complete. In this report, I have added categories for all-time team composite records as well as career coaching information that now includes non-conference and post-season games.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference athletic Web site (www.stpaulathletics.org). You will not only find basketball stats but results and standings from all conference athletic events.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.

Central can indeed say that the 2006-07 team was, perhaps, the best team ever to play girls' basketball in the state of Minnesota. And it has the stats to prove it. 32-0.....that, in itself, speaks volumes. The 32 wins are the most ever by a Minnesota girls' team in one season. The 2,734 points scored this year shattered the state girls' record, held previously by Minnesota Valley Lutheran of New Ulm in 2006 (2,489 points). The Minutemen would average a lofty 85.4 points per game, easily surpassing the previous state record of 82.3, by Minneapolis North in 1998. The 85.4 average is the eighth highest ever recorded by a girls' basketball team in the country!!

There is no doubt that in years to come, there will be many great teams to participate in Minnesota high school girls basketball. But those teams will have a lofty goal in attempting to achieve the same greatness and be as good as the 2006-07 Central girls' basketball team!!
