FOREWORD

The 35th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 34th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central won its eighth consecutive city title (tenth overall), and, in the process, extended its conference winning streak to 62, the second longest in conference history. The record, held by Cretin-Derham Hall, is 67. The Minutemen would end their overall winning streak (conference, non-conference and post-season) at 34 when they lost the second game of the season to Centennial (the streak extended back to March of 2006). Mpls. South proved a thorn in the side of the Willie Taylor coached Central squad as they would lose to the Tigers during the regular season and in the annual Twin Cities Game. They breezed through the Section 4AAAA tournament, qualifying for the state tournament (and were seeded #3). As if a defending state

champion needed more motivation, the seeding seemed to raise the level of play for Central as it beat St. Cloud Tech and Eastview to advance to the state championship game. Only that pesky Mpls. South team stood in their way. Proving the old axiom that it is tough to beat a team three times in the same season, Central defended its crown and defeated South for the second year in a row in the championship game!! Congratulations to Coach Taylor and his talented Central team.


There were other team and individual highlights from this past conference season. Highland Park and Johnson would tangle in an early-season match-up and, after the final horn sounded, there were numerous seasonal highs (with a conference record set, as well). The teams combined for 87 total free throws attempted, the fifth highest amount ever in a girls' game in the state (the record is 100 in a game between LeRoy-Ostrander and Rushford-Peterson in 1997). It shattered the conference record, as well (81 by Central and Como Park in 2002). Seasonal high marks were also achieved in most free throws attempted by one team (Highland Park with 50), free throws made (by both teams, a total of 46), fouls by one team (35 by Johnson), fouls by both teams (61), players fouled out by a team (Highland Park with four), and most players fouling out by both teams in a game (seven). However, none of these set conference records. Central would lead the conference in free throwing with a 65.0% conversion rate, the fifth highest percentage ever by one team during conference play.

On an individual basis, Highland Park junior Adele Simerson-Wallfred won the scoring title with an average of 20.6 ppg. She became the first Scotsman to ever average twenty points during the conference season. Kiara Buford ended her fantastic career at Central with 670 conference points, tying her for 16th on the overall career points list. She would also lead the conference in free throwing and finish her career as the second best free-thrower ever in conference games. She would make 77.6% of her free throws in her career, just barely behind the all-time leader (Janet Klees from Highland Park, 77.9%).
