FOREWORD

The 36th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 35th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central continued its dominance of the conference by winning its ninth consecutive city title. The Minutemen would surpass the record 67 straight conference wins that Cretin-Derham Hall attained during the 1996-2001 seasons. They currently own the record with 74 (and still counting!!) The Willie Taylor-coached squad would lose in the sectional semifinals to White Bear Lake (the ultimate section winner) and end a four-year streak of appearing in the state tournament. They had won an impressive two state championships and two third place trophies in those four years.

There were other team and individual highlights from this past conference season. Humboldt won a school-record 18 games (besting the previous high of 15 in 1983). They also won two post-season games, an achievement Humboldt had accomplished only one other time (also in 1983). The Hawks also lead the conference in free throw conversion, the first time it had ever accomplished that feat. Como Park and Humboldt would set a conference record when the two teams would make 15 three-point field goals in one game (breaking the record of 14 that had been achieved four times).

On an individual basis, Central's Theairra Taylor would conclude her career by winning the conference scoring title (her second). She became the only player in conference history to win scoring titles three years apart (she won the title as a freshman at Como Park in 2006). Her career conference point total of 796 ranks tenth all-time and her average of 16.6 in conference games is seventh best. Senior Ayana Hicks became the first female basketball player at Humboldt to score 1,000 points in all games for her career. She would finish at 1,037 points. Her sister Annessa again led the conference in converted three-point field goals and now has a conference career total of 73, just 15 shy of the all-time leader (Jodi Loeblein from Harding and Cretin-Derham Hall in 1992-1995).

Statistically, there were a few items that stand out. Scoring this year dropped an alarming 18.2% and, in the process, the losing teams would average 32.5 ppg, the lowest since 1977 when the teams averaged 29.8 ppg. This decrease in scoring, especially by the non-winning teams, is a direct correlation to the inception of the "Mercy Rule," the use of running time in the last one-fourth of the game when a team is winning by 35 points or more. From a personal standpoint, this new rule deprives players, especially those that normally don't play much in a varsity game, the opportunity to play and compete. That's just my opinion, of course.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.
