FOREWORD

The 38th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 37th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central returned to the top of the conference standings, displacing Humboldt as city champions. It is the tenth title won or shared by the Minutemen in the last eleven years. Another one of Humboldt's talented Hicks family finished her conference career in a blaze of glory. Angelina Hicks would win the scoring title with a second-best ever average of 26.6 (only Harding's Shannon Loeblein averaged more with 27.5 points per game in 1990). She became the second sister combination to win a scoring title (sister Annessa won the title last year and Shannon and Jodi Loeblein did it in the late 1980s and early 1990s). Angelina would finish her conference career with 670 points, tying her for 18th place on the all-time scoring list. Her conference career average was 15.23 points, ranking her 16th most prolific in that category. Ms. Hicks would also nail seven three-point field goals in a game against Harding, tying the city record. She finished her conference career with 60 three-pointers, fourth best all-time. Angelina's teammate Teresa Larocque would win the free-throwing title and end her career as the third best free throw shooter (converting 76.9%) in conference history.

Of particular note regarding free throwing pertains to Johnson's Audrey Awich. The sophomore, in a game at Humboldt on January 7, made 17 out of 17 free throws! This shattered the conference-best mark of 12-12 shared by three individuals and also surpassed the boys' record of 14-14. The 17-17 perfecto is one short of the state record of 18-18, held by three individuals, most recently by Jenny Theisen of Champlin Park in 2007. Audrey also tied two conference records in making 17 free throws in a game and converting 70 of them in one season. Audrey helped her Johnson team convert 69.4% of their free throws, the second highest team average ever in conference games (only Cretin-Derham Hall's 1995 average of 71.1% ranks higher).
