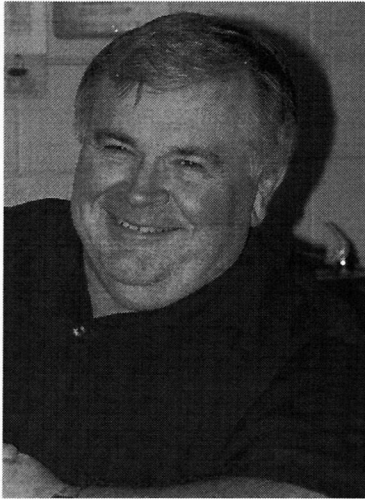

FOREWORD

The 39th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 38th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

For the fifth time in conference history, there was a tie for the conference girls' basketball title, with Central and Highland Park sharing the crown. It was Highland Park's first title since they were co-champs with Hill-Murray in 1986. The Scots also won their first conference game over Central since 1995. Central has won or shared the title every year but once since 2001 (Humboldt won it in 2010).



Highland Park won 20 games overall for the first time since 1986 (when they won 22). The Lady Scots represented St. Paul in the Twin Cities Game and defeated Roosevelt 67-63 (ending a four-year losing streak to Minneapolis). Both the Minutemen and Scots were denied the chance to play in the state tournament when they lost in the Section 4AAAA and 4AAA finals.

Other team highlights: Johnson and Como Park tied a conference record when they collectively made 15 three-point field goals on one game on January 31. When Humboldt defeated Johnson 92-72 on February 17, the two teams combined for 164 points, tying for second the most points by two teams in a game (the record is 170 by Harding and Highland Park in 1983). For the first time ever, Como Park led the conference in free throwing, making them at a 60.0% rate.

Humboldt junior LaShay Holt won the scoring title with an impressive 21.7 average (it's the ninth highest single season average ever). She became the third consecutive Hawk to win the title (Annessa Hicks won it in 2010 and her sister Angelina achieved it in 2011). Audrey Awich became the first Johnson player since 1990 to lead the conference in free throwing. She improved her conference career free throwing conversion rate to 73.7%, the ninth best ever.

Central coach Willie Taylor passed the 300 win total in his 14th year as a head coach in St. Paul. Currently he has 310 victories. Only Tom Gunderson (Harding and Johnson) and Tom Cody (Cretin-Derham Hall) have more wins with 389 each.
