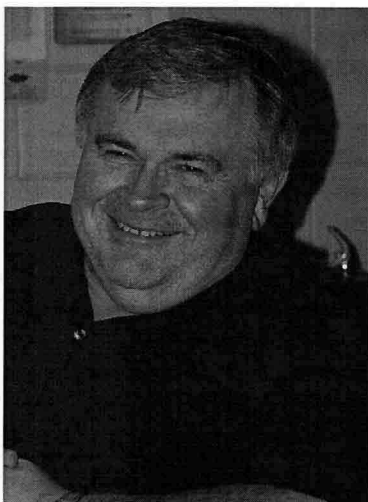

## FOREWORD

The 40th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 39th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

Central roared through the conference season undefeated to win the city title. The Minutemen have won or shared the title in 12 of the past 13 years. They would go on to defeat Washburn in the Twin Cities Game and capture the Section 4AAAA title, qualifying them for the state for the tenth time ever. In a hard fought game, they would lose in the first round to Osseo, 63-56.



There were numerous records set or tied this season. The conference, on the whole, experienced its best year ever in free throw shooting. The girls converted from the charity stripe at a 58.0% clip, clearly besting the previous record of 56.2% in 2001. In a February 14 game between Johnson and Central, the teams would set or tie three conference records. They would tie the record of most free throws made by both teams, 49 (tying the record held by Central and Como Park in 2002). Records were set in that same game for free throws attempted by one team (Central had 54, eclipsing the previous record of 51 by Humboldt in 1996) and for combined free throws attempted (the two teams tried 88 free throws, narrowly breaking the record of 87 previously held by Highland Park and Johnson in 2008). Como Park won a record 19 games, easily topping its previous high of 14 wins in 2005. The 1,535 points scored by the Cougars for the season was also a school record.

On an individual basis, Humboldt's LaShay Holt would win the scoring title for the second year in a row. Her conference average of 23.7 was the third best ever. She would end her conference career with a 15.18 ppg average over her four years (never missing a conference game), placing her 17th on the all-time scoring list. She also set records this year in free throws made (80) and attempted (126). Central's Betsy MacDonald would end her four-year career by making 56 three-point field goals in conference games, tying her for eighth all-time. Audrey Awich would close out her four-year Johnson career by making 74.0% of her conference free throws, ranking her seventh best all-time. The record she set back in 2011 will probably stand for years: she was 17-17 in free throwing in one game over Humboldt. To these and all of the other senior girls, thanks for the memories, gals.

The conference will be losing one of its long-time coaches this year as Central's Willie Taylor will leave us for greener pastures. During his 15-year tenure at Central, he amassed an eye-popping conference mark of 172-10 (a winning percentage of 94.5%, easily the best ever). His overall winning percentage was 80.0% (336-84), second only to Hill-Murray's Bill Wold (84.2%). His team's would play in the state tournament six times, winning the state title in 2007 and 2008. That 2007 team would finish with an undefeated record of 32-0. Many people consider that team one of the finest girls' basketball teams ever! Thanks, Willie, for your dedication to the conference over the years.....and best of luck in the future!
