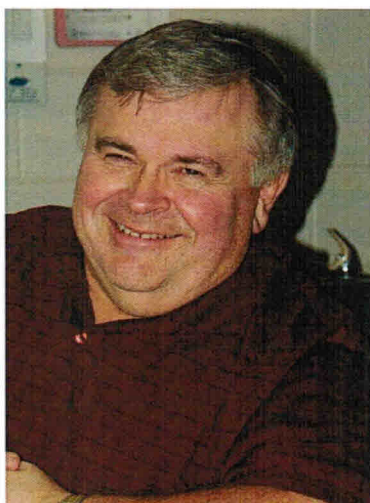

FOREWORD

The 41st season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 40th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

It would be impossible to begin this report without mentioning the weather we all had to endure this past winter. The snow and cold led to eight conference games being rescheduled and nearly a dozen non-conference games that were either postponed or cancelled. It should make us all appreciate any winter that is "normal."

Before I go any further, you know that I annually like to compare the current year's statistics with those from last year. With the addition of Washington, the conference played 12 more games, making it impossible to directly compare the two seasons. So that some sort of comparison could be made, I added a proportional percentage to last year's statistics. Any comparison percentage that has been adjusted in such a fashion is noted with an asterisk (*).



Central continued its mastery of the conference with an undefeated season for first-year coach Marta Waalen. They have now won or shared the title in 13 of the past 14 years and have won 22 straight conference games. The league saw an end to its longest-ever losing streak at 48 games when Harding defeated Washington on January 24. The Minutemen would add the Twin Cities Game title to its list of accomplishments this season with an exciting 71-67 win over Washburn. Seeded third in the Section 4AAAA tournament, they would defeat the #2 seeded team (Roseville) and then White Bear Lake (the #1 seeded team) and advance to the State Tournament for the eleventh time. In a nip-and-tuck first round game, Central would fall to Eastview (the eventual state champion) by a score of 63-58.

There were two conference team records tied, both in the same game. Johnson would make 14 three-point field goals in a game against Washington, tying the record held by Humboldt in a game against Harding in 2007. Johnson and Washington would combine for 15 threes in that game, tying the record held jointly by Humboldt and Como Park (in 2009) and in a 2012 game between Johnson and Como Park.

Como Park's Andrayah Adams would win the scoring title, becoming only the third Cougar to ever achieve this honor. The talented sophomore would also set a conference record when she made six three-pointers in one half against Highland Park. Her total of 29 threes for the conference season is the third highest ever (and the most for a 12-game conference season). She would finish a close second in free throw conversion for the season (Central's Jada Jones would capture that award). In her first two seasons, Andrayah has logged the best career free throw shooting percentage ever, making her free throws at a record 79.4% pace.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.
