## FOREWORD

The 42nd season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 41st annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

Como Park and Central tied for the conference title. It was the first girls' basketball title ever for the Cougars. In the process, they halted Central's 23-game conference winning streak. Como Park would represent St. Paul in the annual Twin Cities Game and, in the first overtime game ever played in this series, would win a 70-65 thriller over Washburn. It was the fourth straight win for St. Paul, boosting the overall record in favor of St. Paul to 25-16.

Como Park would win a school record 20 games this year (their previous best was 19 in 2013). They would also set a conference record in making three-point field goals by connecting on 90 of them (the previous best was 85 by Johnson in 2003).



Most of the excitement in the conference would center on individual accomplishments. Como Park junior Andrayah Adams and freshman Makayla Van Nett would each set a conference record when they nailed nine three-point field goals in separate games (Van Nett against Johnson and Adams against Harding). In that game with Harding, Andrayah made a conference record eight three-pointers in the second half (that record may stand for a while). Andrayah would connect on 39 threes for the conference season, also a record (the previous record was 35 by Johnson's Krista Geiger-Simpson in 2003).

Andrayah would again win the scoring title with a blistering 26.6 ppg average (third highest ever). She would lead the state in scoring with her 847 points in all games (a 29.2 average). The previous season high points scored was by Shannon Loeblein for Harding in 1990 with 747 points. She has now scored 1,734 points while at Como Park and next year she should pass the all-time mark of 2,375 points scored by Angel Robinson in 2003-2007. If you add the points she scored at Mpls. Edison in seventh grade and Mpls. South as an eighth grader, she has amassed a total of 2,500 points in her five year career. She also became only the fourth female player to score 40 or more points in a conference game when she tallied 40 against Harding. She also was the best free throw shooter in the conference with a conversion percentage of 77.1%. For her conference career, she ranks first with 78.3% of her free throws made.

There were two seniors that distinguished themselves this year that certainly deserve some recognition, Central's Chelcie Kizart and Johnson's Lauryn Smith joined Adams in averaging over 20 points a conference game. It is the first time since 1984 that three individuals would boast averages over 20 in the same season. Kizart would join the 1,000 point club for her career, scoring 532 this year and finishing with 1,203 points. Smith would score a school best 37 points in a conference game against Harding. Her seasonal total of 531 points was the second highest ever for a Governor (Ebony Black scored 536 in 2004). Her career total of 1,288 points would put her in fifth place on the all-time list at Johnson. To our outgoing seniors, thanks for the memories and best of luck!
