FOREWORD

The 43rd season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 42nd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

Como Park would win the conference title outright for the first time in its history (they tied for the title with Central last year), finishing with a perfect 12-0 mark. The Cougars, under first year coach Alexis Gray-Lawson, would go on to win the Twin Cities Game for the second year in a row, capturing the title this year with the highest scoring T.C. Game ever (a 91-89 conquest over Southwest). They would go on to win the Section 4AAA title and play in their first state tournament ever, losing in the first round to Becker, 62-57. They finished the season with a school-record 24 wins, eclipsing last year's record of 20.



Numerous conference records were set at both the team and individual level. Como Park scored a conference (and state) record 83 points in one half over Humboldt. They would set team records in most three-point field goals made in one game (15, against Central) and most three-pointers in a conference season with a total of 124. Harding would defeat Central for the first time since 1993 (the Knights would also win their first playoff game since 1993). Washington ended a 34-game conference losing streak by winning its first conference game since rejoining the league in 2014. That streak first began in 1978 as the "old" Washington.

On an individual level, Washington's Samiya McCaa established a school conference record of 39 points in a game with Johnson. Como Park's Makayla Van Nett would break the single game conference scoring record when she tallied 46 points against Humboldt (besting the previous high of 44 by Harding's Shannon Loeblein in 1990). She also smashed the conference record of three-pointers in one season (59), breaking the mark of 39 established last year by teammate Andrayah Adams. Lastly, she won the conference scoring title this year with an average of 22.3 ppg, ending Andrayah's two-year reign as scoring champion.

And then there is Andrayah....she would become the fourth female conference player to score 2,000 point. During her four-year run at Como Park, her final total of 2,473 would easily surpass the previous record total of 2,375 by Angel Robinson (Johnson/Central in 2003-2007). For her six-year career (she played for Mpls. Edison in seventh grade; as an eighth grader at Mpls. South), she would tally 3,239 points, placing her eleventh on Minnesota's all-time scoring list. Her career conference average of 19.7 is the all-time highest. She would also find herself in fourth place in conference scoring with 905 points. She is the all-time conference free throw shooting and three-point field goal converter. She made 78.2% of her conference free throws in her four year career as well as making 101 conference three-pointers. Her adept free throwing mark may stand for a while. However, her record for three-pointers could be broken next year by teammate Makayla Van Nett (she trails by only eleven with a career total of 90 with two years remaining in her career). Congratulations to Andrayah for a fantastic career and, to all of our outgoing seniors, thanks for the memories and best of luck!!
