FOREWORD

The 44th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 43rd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

This season saw the conference playing its 2,000th league game along with surpassing the total of 200,000 points scored. For the record, there have been 2,009 conference games with 200,217 points scored in those games in the past 44 years.



Como Park repeated as conference champions, finishing with an unblemished 12-0 mark in the conference. The Cougars extended their record school conference winning streak to 28 games. Como Park also went on to win the Twin Cities Game over Mpls. South and extend St. Paul's mastery in this game to six straight wins. St. Paul leads in the overall series 27-16. Unfortunately for the conference, it did not have a girls' team advance to a section final this year. But there were numerous team and individual highlights in conference games. The future bodes well for the conference as only one of the top fifteen scorers in the conference was a senior. Matter of fact, three of those top fifteen are attending middle school!!

Leading the pack this year was ninth grader Aliza Karlen from Central. She is the first freshman to win the scoring title since Como Park's Theairra Taylor achieved it in 2006. She would smash conference records in points scored and in average points per game. Her 334 points and average of 27.8 per game surpassed Harding's

Shannon Loeblein's previous records set in 1990 when she scored 330 points while averaging 27.5. Aliza's 43 points against Humboldt shattered the Central record for points scored in a conference game (previously held by Kiara Buford's 35 points against Como Park in 2006). Como Park's Makayla VanNett duplicated the 43 point fete when she totaled that number against Harding on February 6. It was in that game that Makayla made 13 three-point field goals to not only break her conference record of 10 but, in the process, tied the state record held by Parkers Prairie's Sari Noga in 2008. On a national scale, it ranks in a tie for 11th all-time!! The team would make 18 threes in that game, breaking the conference record of 15 that Como Park set last year. This total of 18 is tied for third best in state history (Waconia holds the record of 23 in a game during the 2014 season).

Mikayla also saw her career points in the conference swell to 673 points, ranking 19th all time. It is conceivable that after her senior season next year, she will emerge as the all-time leading point scorer in the conference. She already holds the record for conference three point baskets with 130 in her conference career. Aliza Karlen from Central not only won the scoring title, she also finished first in free throw conversion with a superb 80.3% average.

Some other team highlights were Washington winning its first playoff game since 1975 (and only the second ever). Humboldt's "C" team won the city title, the first time a Hawk team has won the city championship at that level.
