FOREWORD

The 45th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 44th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Como Park once again won the conference championship with a perfect 12-0 record. They now have won a school-record 40 consecutive conference games (fourth longest streak in conference history). The Cougars did St. Paul proud by winning the annual Twin Cities game over Mpls. South 80-74. St. Paul has now won seven straight Twin Cities tilts and holds an overall edge in the series with 28 wins in the 44 games played. There was one overtime game played this year, the first o.t. conference game played since 2012. For the second year in a row, no St. Paul team advanced to a section final.

This annual report affords everyone the chance to compare statistics from one year to the next. Noticeable this year was a decrease in scoring (12%), three-point field goals (19%), free throws made and attempted (19% and 13% respectively) and in fouls (6%).

Humboldt won 17 games this year, just one shy of a Hawk-best 18 victories they logged in 2009. Central made 64.1% of their conference free throws, the eleventh best team total in conference history. Como Park also dominated in making three-point field goals by making 103 of them in their 12 conference games.

Central's sophomore whiz Aliza Karlen repeated as scoring champion. She became the first player to ever have two scoring titles by the end of her tenth grade season. Her 22.1 average in the conference this year ranks tied for tenth best in the history of the conference for one season. Her career average of 25.1 in the conference ranks first and it's not even close (next best is 19.7) Makayla Van Nett of Como Park finished her career with several records that probably won't be broke for a long time, if ever. Her conference career total in three-point field goals is 174, she holds the record for the most in one season (59 in 2016) and most made in one game of 13 (against Harding last season which still remains in a tie for first in state history). She crossed the 2,000 point threshold this year, finishing with 2,119 points. Her career total of 373 three-pointers ranks in a tie for eighth in Minnesota history. She scored 917 points in her conference career which ranks fourth all-time in St. Paul (never missing a game). Other senior highlights: Washington's Samiya McCaa is her school's all-time scoring leader with 669 conference points, which ranks 23rd in city history. Harding's Emma Ogitchida was injured this year and couldn't compete and see if she could improve on the sixth best career average that she owns in the conference with 16.9 points a game. Como Park's Autumn Tucker made 73 three-pointers in conference games in her career which is sixth-best all-time. Highland Park's Ariana Owens joined Autumn on the all-time three-pointers list when she finished her career with 59 (eighth best all-time). To all of this year's seniors, thanks for the memories!!
