FOREWORD

The 46th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 45th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding. A quick stats note – because of a forfeiture there was one less conference game played. Since I like to compare this season's numbers to last season, I prorated this year's numbers to reflect a 42-game season. Whenever this was done, I have noted the percentage with an asterisk ()*



Como Park won its fifth consecutive (fourth outright) conference title, again finishing with an unblemished 12-0 mark. They have now won 52 consecutive conference games, the third longest in conference history. The Alexis Gray-Lawson coached Cougars would do St. Paul proud by defeating Mpls. South 56-55 in the annual Twin Cities Game. It was the eighth straight win for St. Paul (fifth straight for Como Park—no other team has done that), who now lead the overall series with a 29-16 record. No St. Paul team advanced to their section final although Como Park did lose to DeLaSalle, the eventual Class AAA champion, in the Section 4AAA semifinals. Johnson ended its 41-game conference losing streak when they beat Washington in January.

The season saw two games that set some conference and are even mentioned in state records. On January 22, in a game at Harding, Humboldt committed 37 fouls (tying the conference record). The two teams combined for a record 63 fouls. Harding would step up to the free throw line 59 times (a conference record and tied for the fifth most in state history in FTA in a game). Both teams combined for 92 attempts (another conference record and eighth most in state history). On the flip side of the coin was the February 1 game of Highland Park at Washington. Conference records were set when: Highland Park did not commit a foul for the game; the two teams combined for only three total fouls; and only one free throw was attempted in the game (by Highland Park).

There was a noticeable lack of seniors on the teams this year. Of the 94 players that participated in a conference game, there were only 11 twelfth graders. Como Park did not have a senior and Central and Highland Park had only one!! Two of the outgoing seniors, Piper Flemming from Humboldt and Iyana Rodgers-Neely from Harding, completed their conference careers by both making 60 three-point field goals, tied for seventh-best all-time. Como Park's conference MVP freshman Ronnie Porter won the scoring title (18.5 points per game) while junior teammate Dinnea Riley won the free throw title with a 75% conversion rate.

Lastly, I have heard that Washington will not have a varsity girls' basketball team next season. I am hoping that this is a temporary situation, not only for next year's orphaned Washington team, but also those future Eagle girls basketball players. I guess we will have to wait and see what develops but I hope they return to varsity action soon.

You will not only find basketball stats but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events.
