FOREWORD

The 47th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 46th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding. A quick stats note – because Washington did not play in the conference this season, 11 less conference games were played. Since I like to compare this season's numbers to those from last season, a direct comparison is not possible. So I computed the average statistic from last season and pro-rated that number to create a total that could be used for comparison sake. Whenever this was done, I have noted the percentage with an asterisk ()*

It was with a heavy heart that I finished the work on this year's report. Who would have ever thought that, during our lifetime, a world-wide pandemic would hold us hostage from doing even the simplest of things? The severity of COVID-19 impacts all of us. Please stay safe during these troubling times...hopefully, we will prevail!!



Como Park would again dominate in the conference, winning its sixth consecutive (fifth outright) city title, finishing with an unblemished 10-0 mark. They have now won 62 consecutive conference games, the third longest in conference history. The Alexis Gray-Lawson coached Cougars would again capture the Twin Cities Title by defeating Mpls. South 68-61. It was the ninth straight win for St. Paul (sixth straight for Como Park—no other team has done that), who now lead the overall series with a 30-16 record. The Cougars would advance to the Section 3AAA finals, losing to Simley. Humboldt would get to the Section 4AA semis, losing to Concordia Academy (who ultimately would claim the section title). The Hawks would win 20 games overall, a school record.

On an individual basis, Como Park sophomore Ronnie Porter repeated as the league's leading scorer. Five of the past seven scoring champions have walked the halls of Como Park. For her three year Cougar career, she has a conference average of 16.4 ppg along with her 526 points. With two years remaining in her career, who knows how high she can climb on the overall list of scorers? Humboldt's Makayla Mapp became only the third Hawk player to lead the conference in free throwing.

There was again this season a noticeable lack of seniors on the teams. Of the 71 players that scored in a conference game, there were only 17 twelfth graders. Como Park and Central had only two seniors, Humboldt had one and Johnson did not have any! This can only mean better things for the conference. To those outgoing seniors, best of luck!! And speaking of good news for next year, Washington will rejoin the conference! I was glad to hear that our conference will once again have representation from every city school.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball stats but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events. Previous stats books are also posted on the site.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.
