FOREWORD

The 48th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This 47th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding. Just a quick stats note – because Washington played in the conference this year, a total of ten more conference games were played. Since I like to compare this season's numbers to those from last season, a direct comparison is not possible. So I computed the average statistic from last season and pro-rated that number to create a total that could be used for comparison sake. Whenever this was done, I have noted the percentage with an asterisk (*)

The pandemic continued across the world and it affected our basketball season, as well. The regular season started on January 15 this year, almost nine weeks later than normal and nearly two weeks later than most teams in the state. Although 18 regular season games were played by most statewide, St. Paul restricted the number to conference games only (and fans were not allowed to attend). The six non-conference games lost represented a third of a season in games that weren't played. For the first time since its inception in 1975, no Twin Cities Girls' Basketball Game was played. Fortunately, compared to many fall sports, there was a completed post-season of competition. Let's hope next year our basketball season (and our country) returns to some semblance of normalcy. In the meantime, stay safe!!



Como Park was again the dominant team in the conference, winning its seventh consecutive (sixth outright) city title, finishing with an unblemished 10-0 mark. They have now won 72 consecutive conference games, six shy of tying Central for the longest winning streak in conference history. They set records in points scored in a game, greatest average points scored in each contest, and in largest point differential. The Cougars would again advance to the Section 3AAA finals, this year losing to St. Croix Lutheran in overtime. Washington returned to play in the conference this year after a one-year absence. It is good to see all seven conference schools playing varsity girls hoops.

On an individual basis, Como Park junior Ronnie Porter claimed the conference scoring championship for the third year in a row. She becomes only the third female to accomplish this fete (the others were Margaret Nowlin of Cretin-Derham Hall and Harding's Shannon Loeblein). She continued to climb the ladder in scoring – her 26.1 PPG average in conference games was the fifth highest ever. Career-wise, she moved to 16th on the all-time points list (761 pts.) and her conference average of 18.6 is fifth best. Who knows what records she will break next year as a senior? Central's Alayjza Campbell led the league in made three-pointers with 33. She finished her conference career with 70 treys, eighth best all time. And speaking of three-pointers, Como Park and Central combined for a whopping record 25 threes in their game on February 11, the Cougars making 16 to Central's nine.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball stats but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events. Previous stats books are also posted on the site.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.
