FOREWORD

The 49th season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This 48th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

This season the coaches voted to reduce the number of conference games to a single round-robin. The conference hadn't seen so few girls' conference basketball games since 1976. But back then, there were nine teams in the conference so there were still 36 games played. This year, because of Johnson dropping girls' basketball in mid-December and with Humboldt not playing Como Park, only 14 games were played. That's hardly a good measuring stick to use since it represents only one-fifth of the season. Keep this in mind as you look at the stats in this report.

Just a quick note – 14 games were played this year compared to the 40 that were played last year. Since I like to compare this season's numbers to those from last season, a direct comparison is not possible. So I computed the average statistic from last season and pro-rated that number to create a total that could be used for comparison sake. Whenever this was done, I have noted the percentage with an asterisk ()*



Como Park was again the dominant team in the conference, winning its eighth consecutive (seventh outright) city title, finishing with an unblemished 5-0 mark. They have now won 77 consecutive conference games, one shy of tying Central for the longest winning streak in conference history. Como would win its seventh consecutive Twin Cities Game, beating Southwest 65-51. It was St. Paul's tenth straight TC Title. The Cougars vanquished all in the Section 3AAA tournament, advancing to their second-ever State Tournament. After disposing of Grand Rapids in the first round 76-57, they ran into a hot-shooting Totino-Grace team (the eventual state champ), losing 86-72. They would come back strong and capture third place honors with a thrashing of Mankato East, 91-69. The Olonda England coached Cougars finished the season with a 24-7 record, tying the 2016 Como Park team with the most wins in a season.

On an individual basis, Harding senior Grace Davis-Chavez won the scoring title with an average of 22.2 ppg (that's the tenth highest ever in one season). Grace joined the 1000 point club in her final game at Harding (1,006 pts.) Como Park senior Ronnie Porter ended her career in a blaze of glory. Her conference career total of 815 points ranks tenth all-time. Her average for her five years of conference play was 18.5 ppg (fifth most on the all-time list). She finished with 2,174 points scored in her career. A pair of Cougar seniors also deserves some mention: Jada James had 1,129 career points while Kaylynn Asberry ended her six years of playing in St. Paul with 1,891 points (she played her first year in St. Paul at Highland Park).

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball stats but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events. Previous stats books are also posted on the site.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.
