FOREWORD

The 51st season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This year marks the fiftieth year that I have produced a statistical report for girls' basketball. Who would have thought that, back in 1975, it would be the first of fifty? See the next page for more information about that first report.

With so few conference games being played again this year (14), this report is pared down in size. After the 2021-22 report, it was obvious that it was not a true sampling of a team's individual accomplishments. With less than 20% of a team's games being used, it really did not capture the essence of what I want to achieve by producing such a report.



Como Park, for the ninth consecutive season, won the conference championship outright. In the process, the Olondo England-coached Cougars have now won a record 87 straight conference games. Unfortunately, they once again fell to Roosevelt in the Twin Cities Game 79-72. The Cougars lost to Roosevelt in the regular season, as well. And, wouldn't you know it, they would face the Teddies for a third time in the Section 3AA finals (they were the only St. Paul team to advance to the section finals). That section final game with Roosevelt was an exciting game with a less-than-desired finish. Late in the second half, Como Park trailed by a score of 50-49 and they missed a lay-up with just a few seconds on the clock. On the ensuing battle for the rebound, Como Park secured it and was fouled with 2.3 seconds remaining on the clock. A one-on-one was attempted but the front end was missed, Roosevelt got the rebound and the game ended. Tough way to lose a game that would get you to the State Tournament! They have a young team returning next year so it should prove to be a good learning experience.

When this season began, Johnson once again tried to field a varsity team. But, similar to the last two year, the team disbanded early on. However, Washington welcomed the Johnson girls and the two teams formed a Washington/Johnson co-op. It certainly helped them as they won a school record 17 games!

I want to remind coaches that there is great source of keeping your seasonal individual statistics. It may not seem important now, but when you are attempting to find out how many career points a player has scored (like a 1,000 points), unless you have all of the old score books, you are out of luck. With the constant change of head coaches, retrieving old score books may be impossible. I strongly urge you to visit the Star Tribune hub and add your individual scoring to each of your games. If you have a copy of last year's score book, you can go back and enter them. Their records go back as far as the 2010-2011 season. However, they are only as good as the coach or scorer that uses it for all of the games. If I haven't convinced you to use it this year, please consider it for next year!!

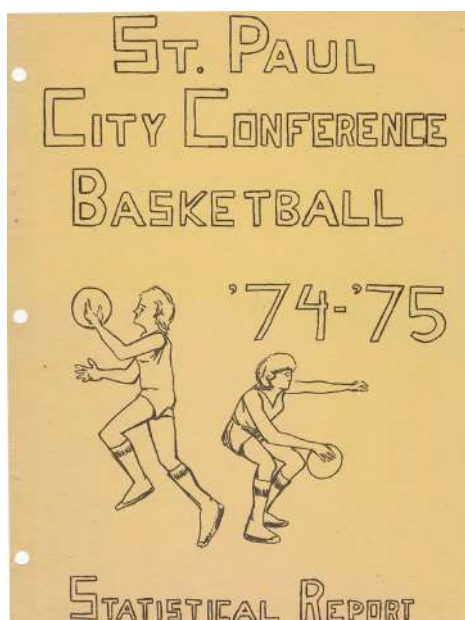
On an individual basis, Highland Park's senior Tereya McDaniel-Vaughn won the scoring title with a fine 25.4 PPG average. There were nine girls that maintained a 10.0+ average in conference games and they are listed in this report. Tereya also joined the 45 other past St. Paul girls in achieving 1,000 career points (she finished her career with 1,041 points).

Don't forget that other statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball stats but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events. Previous stats books are also posted on the site.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball. See ya.

HOW IT ALL BEGAN.....

The first season of girl's basketball in the conference was in 1973-1974. It wasn't until 1974-1975 that I began to have the coaches complete a form for each of their home conference games. The first report contained 23 pages. As the years passed, I included more and more information as well as doing additional archival research that continued to embellish each annual report.

The first 27 versions of the report were typed and duplicated "old school" by using an antiquated mimeograph machine I acquired from Mechanic Arts High School after it closed in 1976. An IBM Selectric typewriter was used to create the mimeograph stencils. It wasn't until 2002 that I started using a word processor which afforded me the chance to duplicate reports using a high-speed copier.
