FOREWORD



The ninth season of St. Paul City Conference Girls' Basketball is over. And as I have for each of those nine years, I present to you my statistical report. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding. I hope you appreciate the time, effort and pride that I have placed in this and past statistical endeavors.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. My special thanks go to retiring Conference Athletic Director "Lefty" Gilleland for his help through the years and wish him well now that he can take it easy. Without the help of all that I have mentioned, this report could never have been produced.

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics for the St. Paul City Conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some sort of recognition (which all players and coaches need and deserve) and to give special recognition to those that excel in a particular category. One must always remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.

This season saw many highlights by both teams and individuals. Hill-Murray won its third consecutive conference title and in the process extended its record conference winning streak to 42 games. The Bill Wold coached Pioneers also tied the conference record for points scored in a game (96 against Como Park). Harding and Highland Park scored 170 points in one game (Harding won 92-78) shattering the conference record for points scored by both teams in a game. Interestingly this is also more points than has ever been scored in a boys' conference game. The Pioneers talented senior Mary Godfrey became the conference's all-time leading scorer, surpassing Harding's Carolyn Biebighauser with 784 career points. Joining Mary in the top ten all-time scorers this season were Central's Stephanie Cummings (fourth place with 626 points); Humboldt's Jenine Fourcloud and Angie Perez (tied for seventh place with 508 points each).

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball, 1982-1983. Happy reading!
